



OFFICIAL RACE SERIES RULES

RACING

- Helmets are required for all racers.
- Lapped racers are required to yield to leaders provided that lead riders are vocal when overtaking other riders. A rider may not bodily interfere or otherwise intentionally impede another racer's progress.
- Unsportsmanlike behavior and/or use of profane or abusive language will not be tolerated.
- Short cutting of a race course is not allowed.
- At the sole discretion of the Race Director, racers may be issued a warning or be disqualified for a violation of any of the above rules.

POINTS SYSTEM

All racers (including kids/youth) will score points in each race as follows:

1 st Place	30 Points
2 nd Place	27 Points
3 rd Place	25 Points
4 th Place	23 Points

All racers must race in at least (2) races to be eligible for the overall series standings. Due to capacity limits on the July 13 race at Oak Creek Mountain Park, no points will be awarded at that race. Therefore, only (4) of the (5) total races will count for a racers season total. No scores will be dropped from the cumulative

season total this season. If a racer changes skill divisions during the season, they will not carry any existing points with them for cumulative season totals.

EQUIPMENT

All bikers must have working front and rear brakes. No cross or road bikes. No drop handle bars. Helmets are required for all racers. No training wheels. Bikes must have pedals and brakes, except for those competing in the TOT (5 & Under) Division, where strider bikes are allowed.

RACE DIVISIONS

Any racer who wins their overall age/skill division may be required to move up in skill level the following season. Racers are solely responsible for knowing which race divisions they are entered in and the start time for their specific race division. Racing age for all racers will be the racer's age as of August 17, 2022. Race organizers reserve the right to combine age divisions for a season in instances where there are less than 5 season pass holders registered for a specific division.

CANCELLATION POLICY

In cases of adverse weather, adverse trail conditions, COVID related restrictions or other unforeseen circumstances, the race organizers reserve the right to any of the following actions:

- Delay start for a period of time
- Shorten race prior to or during race
- Move the start or finish of a course
- Change courses prior to a race
- Reschedule the race
- Cancel the race

PROTESTS

Protests regarding race results will be accepted by the Race Director until the end of the next business day following a race. Race results will be final 24 hours after the results have been posted online.

REFUNDS

If a race is cancelled due to weather, all registered racers will receive a credit and race organizers will attempt to reschedule the race. Requests for other race refunds will be dealt with individually, on a case-by-case basis, and may include a cancellation fee. If a racer cannot attend a race due to COVID-19 quarantine orders or because they suspect that they may have COVID-19, that racer will receive a credit which they can use to register for a future race.
